Site Formation and Infrastructure Works for
Public Housing Development at To Yuen Tung, Tai Po

General Description of Works

The Director of Environmental Protection proposes to execute the sewerage works within the limit of works area as shown on Plan Nos. 426154/GZ/101 to 426154/GZ/106 (the "Plans") annexed hereto and described hereunder. The proposed sewerage works are required to serve the planned development of public housing at To Yuen Tung, Tai Po district.

- 2. The general nature of the proposed sewerage works is as follows:-
 - (i) construction of approximately 1,120 metres of gravity sewers and associated manholes within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans; and
 - (ii) ancillary works including temporary closure and reinstatement of existing footpaths, carriageways, cycle tracks, open space, central reserve/refuge island and amenity area.

Roads to be Closed

3. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Director of Environmental Protection proposes that powers under section 17 of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation may be exercised to close temporary the existing footpath, carriageway, cycle track, open space, central reserve and amenity area or parts thereof, within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans. Temporary alternative accesses will be provided and temporary diversions will be carried out during the construction period as and when required. Further notice, setting out the manner in which the footpath, carriageway, cycle track, open space, central reserve and amenity area or parts thereof are to be closed, will be issued under section 18 of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation as and when required.

Apparatus whose Course or Position to be Altered

4. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Director of Environmental Protection proposes that powers under section 20 of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation may be exercised to require alteration of the course or position of any existing utility service apparatus, such as electricity cables and ducts, telecommunication cables and ducts, water mains, drainage pipes, sewerage pipes, gas pipes and any other service apparatus lying within the limit of works area, and to require repairing of any road surface thereby disturbed. Further notice, setting out the manner in which the course or position of such utility service is to be altered and the repair of any road surface, will be issued under section 20 of the Roads (Works, Use and

Compensation) Ordinance as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation as and when required.
